

EXCLUSIONS TO THE DEFINITION OF INCOME

For the purpose of housing charge calculations the following is a list of exclusions from the definition of income:

1. Earnings of children in regular attendance at recognized institutions of learning, funds for tuition, such as bursaries and contributions from tuition, non-resident family members.
2. Living out or travelling allowances of a family head.
3. Earnings of a working spouse up to \$900 per annum.
4. Income from any source other than social assistance payments of a one parent family, up to \$900, per annum.
5. Capital gains such as: Insurance settlements, inheritances, disability awards and sale of effects.
6. Family allowance payments.
7. Repayable portion of student loans.
8. \$2. Per child per month from the housing charge.
