FLOORING POLICY

[Consistency in all units]

- 1. The standard for the co-op will be:
 - a. Laminate on first floor hallway, dining room and living room.
 - b. Linoleum at kitchen entrances (exceptions possible for units with covered entrances, or landings) and storage rooms.
 - c. Carpet for rest of unit.
 - d. Handicap units will be determined on case by case basis
 - e. Modifications must be approved by co-op and cost above regular to be paid by member.
 - f. Carpet cost is below laminate, and can be requested instead.
- 2. Flooring replacement to be prioritized by the age of old floor, exceptions if unit is vacant.
- 3. Laminate should be done all rooms at once to avoid problems from mismatches.
- 4. Linoleum conditions to be factored along with age when replacing flooring; example, some units have newer linoleum but bad seams; whereas, others have old linoleum but in good condition and won't require replacement.
- 5. Noise factor to be considered for units above handicap units. Noise cancelling padding for laminate or even under the carpet?
